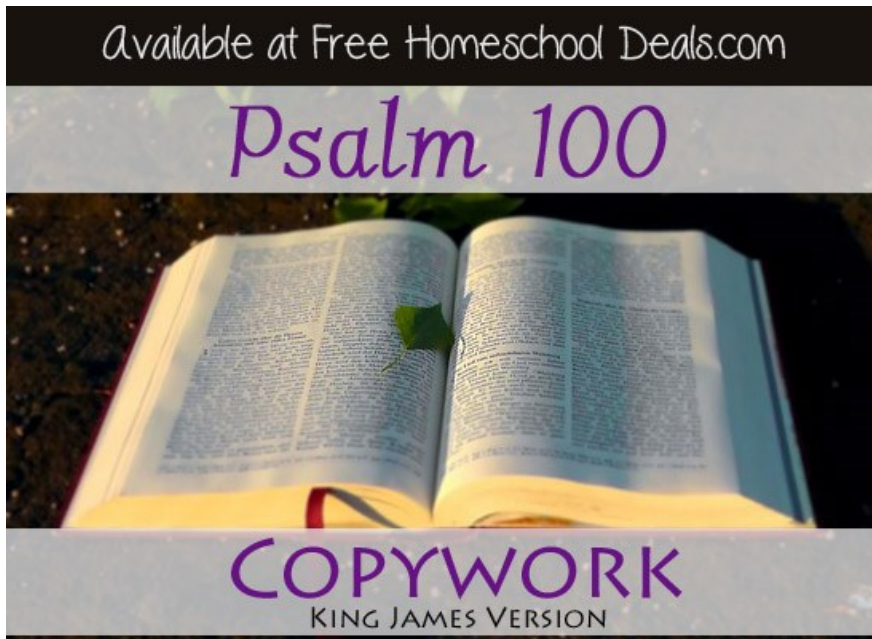

Thank you for choosing to use worksheets and printables from Mama's Learning Corner! I created this copywork activity to use in my home with my own children, and I pray it will bless your family as well.

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A few notes regarding this copywork:

- This is a large section of copywork, and it is not intended for your child to complete it in one sitting! Choose 1 verse or just a section of a verse to work on a couple of days during the week.
- It's often fun for children to have their own "books." To make your child a book, simply print all the pages at once and staple down the side, bind with a machine, or punch holes and tie with yarn. Just making a simple book can sometimes freshen up the task of copywork.
- Are you and your children working on Scripture memorization? This would be a great time to commit Psalm 100 to memory! It is a beautiful psalm of praise. Mama has a few [tips on helping children memorize Scripture](#) if you need new ideas.
- Several of the verses in this section are long. If your child needs extra writing room, there are lined papers at the end of this pdf—elementary and ruled lines. Simply print as many as you need.
